## 2023-24 Annual Performance Report

#### **Performance**

Performance metrics hold LEAs accountable for whether students consistently attain positive educational outcomes and measures whether the students of a particular LEA or school are gaining the knowledge and skills they need to succeed in the next step of their education, including post-graduation.




